



Day 1 Preschool Blizzard Bag Assignment

1. Use this game board, a die or the number cards included to play.
2. Roll a die or draw a number and move that many spaces.
3. You may want to discuss with your child(ren) what to put on the end space. You can draw, add a sticker or put a real object on the end space that is a “prize” when you get there. For example, draw a rain drop on the “start” spot and a flower on the “finish” spot. Add stickers to each spot and talk about what it is, what color it is or what we use it for. If you need stickers, you can talk to your child’s teacher and some can be provided for you. You and your child could even write letters or numbers on the spots and practice letter/number recognition while playing.
4. You can use a penny, a pop cap, a small toy, a piece of candy or any other small items you can think of as a marker.
5. Take turns with your child to play the game. You can practice saying, “My turn” and “Your turn.” while playing.
6. Talk about the numbers on the cards or how many dots on the die.
7. Your child can also practice cutting while cutting out the number cards below.
8. Please send a note to your child’s teacher to tell them how many turns it took to get to the end of the game. Notes are due April 16th.
